



Dear Business Members,

We are committed to providing you with the most up-to-date information as soon as we receive it and want to share the most recent communication we've received regarding the Paycheck Protection Program's (PPP) second round.

As of the close of business on Tuesday, May 4th, 2021, the Small Business Association (SBA) has reached the maximum amount of PPP loan approvals authorized and appropriated by Congress, and therefore will no longer be accepting applications. The full \$292 billion in allocated funding for the Paycheck Protection Program was set to expire May 31st only if funding was still available.

As of Wednesday, May 5th, the SBA has communicated with us that applications that are already submitted, but not yet approved are still eligible for funding. Our team will be reaching out to you directly regarding any loan approvals that have not been delivered by the end of day Tuesday, May 4th.
